The Sustainable Grazing Mentorship Program (SGMP) is a consulting/ mentoring program administered by the Agricultural Research and Extension Council of Alberta (ARECA).

For a nominal fee, the program provides clients access to qualified mentors who understand grazing. These consultants work with you to explore options and develop a plan for your future success.

Finding Your Mentor

We can assign you an expert from our list of grazing consultants (Mentors) or you can choose your own.



What is the fee?

The cost of the service to the farmer/rancher client is \$100, payable to ARECA and collected by the consultant (Mentor) assigned to the client, for the complete service or any part of it.

Who pays the consultant?

The client farmer/ rancher pays the first \$100. The Sustainable Grazing Mentorship Program is also funded by the Environmentally Sustainable Agriculture Initiatives Program (ESAIP), administered by ARECA, and Greencover Canada Regional Technical Assistance Program, administered by the Canadian Cattlemen's Association. This funding pays the mentor, who spends approximately 16 hours creating grazing plans, developing systems, and performing economic analyses of the client's enterprise.
